NOTICE OF CONTINUED HEARING
INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW
FARM-RELATED ZONING AMENDMENTS**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the Town Board will continue the public hearing on an introductory local law entitled "Farm-Related Zoning Amendments" on February 20, 2020, at 7:20 PM. The local law would authorize the Planning Board to waive the site plan public hearing requirement for farm operations, require the Planning Board to waive site plan contents deemed not necessary by the Planning Board, reduce the setback requirement for a building or structure used to house or stable animals to 50 feet from all property lines, require that those buildings and structures, barnyards, silos, barn gutters and animal pens shall be at least 100 feet from water wells, and manure piles shall be at least 200 feet from water wells, and increase the time period for action on site plan applications for non-farm operations to 62 days. With respect to farm operations located in the Town's Scenic Corridor Overlay District, the Planning Board may waive the site plan public hearing requirement if the Board determines that the size, location and appearance of the proposed use or structure will not have an adverse effect on the purposes of the Scenic Corridor Overlay District. A complete copy of the Introductory Local Law is available for inspection at the Clerk's Office.

All persons interested in the Introductory Local Law shall be heard.

The Town of Crawford will make every effort to assure that the hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities. Anyone requiring special assistance and/or reasonable accommodations should contact the Town Clerk.
